#### **FLU VACCINATION**

As you are aware, with all other schools countrywide we are now having to have flu vaccinations for Reception to Y4 done at school by the school nurse team. This will be on 7th November 11.30am. I know some of you are worried about this vaccine and children will only be given it if we have permission. We have information from Public Health England about the vaccine.

"The nasal spray vaccine has a good safety record and unvaccinated contacts are NOT at risk of catching flu from the vaccine, either through being in the same room where flu vaccine has been given or by being in contact with a recently vaccinated individual. Although vaccinated children are known to shed virus for a few days after vaccination, it is less able to spread from person to person than the natural infection. The amount of virus shed is below the levels needed to pass on infection to others and the virus does not survive for long outside of the body. This is in contrast to natural flu infection, which spreads easily during the flu season.

Excluding children from school during the period when the vaccine is being offered, or in the following days is therefore not considered necessary"
