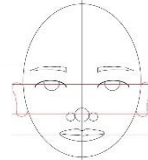

### Vocabulary

**Contrasting** – opposite elements are arranged together e.g. black and white, thick and thin, smooth and rough.



**In proportion** – making sure each piece is the right size and shape to make up a whole picture.



**Repeated** – the same over and over again.



**Portrait** – a piece of art where a person is the main content.



**Self-portrait** – a piece of art where the artist is the main content.



**Painting** – using paint to create a picture or decorate something.

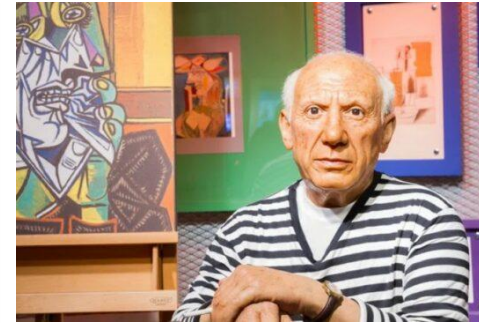
**Theme** – the big idea or message of the art.



**Content** – what is included in the art.



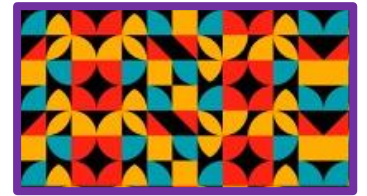
**Process** – how a piece of art was put together.



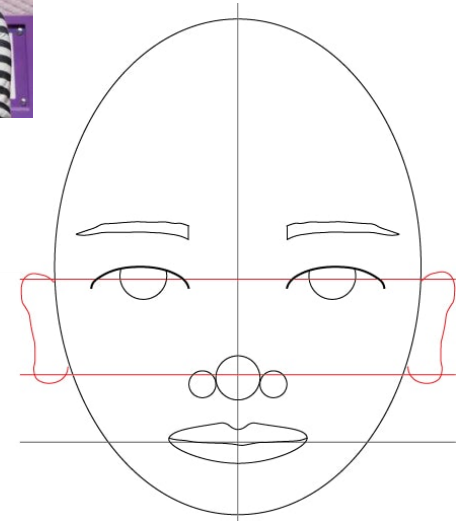

Combine simple shapes to create an overall object.



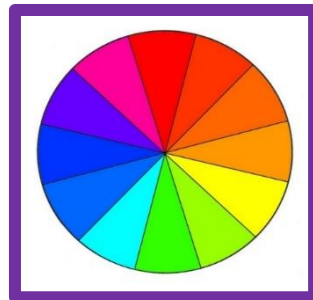
Pure hue

### Elements of Art

**Colour** – how we describe the way our eyes see light. 

**Pattern** – a repeated, decorative design. 

**Line** – a mark made on a surface that joins different points. 

**Shape** – a 2D area.
