Exploring Earth and Space, describing the movement of the Earth and other planets in relation to the sun.

Exploring the moon and it's relationship with Earth.

Investigating the apparent movement of the sun across the sky to understand the Earth's rotation to explain day and night.

YEAR 6 - AUTUMN TERM I How does water create rivers and coasts?

Geography

Our topic this term will focus on rivers and coasts. We begin by learning how rivers are formed, relating specifically to the River Severn. We will be drawing a diagram from the source to the mouth of a river, annotating its features and describing processes such as erosion and deposition. We will locate some of the world's rivers using atlases and digital mapping software and compare them to rivers in the UK. We will then focus on coasts and how they are formed. First, we will explore settlements near coasts and think about why some major cities and towns can be found along the coast of the UK. We will then learn about how waves are formed and how they shape land, helping us to describe why coasts change over time.

Music

Learning how to compose music using technology (Garage Band) through a Music Works ten week workshop.

Focus piece of music: Bronski Beat - Smalltown Boy

Art

Producing drawings of 3D objects, considering tone, light and shade. Using shadows to show the position of a source of light. Using perspective to show fore, middle and back ground.

French

Learning some basic French phonics (è, é, e, eux, eau, qu, gne. ç, en, an) and knowing how to say the date in French.
